
Make an Art Storage Box


This art box will be $3'' \times 6'' \times 3''$ and without a lid.

Use it to hold your artistic bits and pieces while you assemble projects from day to day. Materials: 9" x 12" sheet of white tag board, ruler, pencil, scissors, glue, color media

1. Using a ruler and pencil, make a small tick mark along each side of the tag board, measuring three inches from each corner in both directions.




2. Put the tag board in front of you in *landscape* orientation. Use the ruler to help you draw a dotted line between the top tick mark on the left edge and the top tick mark on the right.




3. Do the same between the bottom tick mark on the left edge and the bottom tick mark on the right.




4. Turn the tag board so it's in *portrait* orientation. Draw a line between the top two ticks marks. This time, draw it solidly for the first three inches and the last three inches. In the middle three inches, draw it dotted.



5. Do the same between the bottom two tick marks.



6. Cut along the solid lines. Stop at the beginning of the dotted part of the lines. DO NOT **CUT ALL THE WAY ACROSS!**



7. Fold up along all the dotted lines.

8. Form into a box shape. Glue overlapping squares together. Get the glue all the way to the edges.

9. Decorate when the glue is dry. Make sure your name is clearly visible on one of the sides.
